utilises Climate Youths project Participatory Videos as the method to facilitate young people's access and understanding climate change while empowering them to take action on the topic. Through this project, organisations from different EU countries will implement a series of training activities focused on fighting against climate change by contributing to the 13th Sustainable Development Goal of the United Nations.

The project is an international synergy between 4 European organisations, namely:

- <u>STANDO Ltd</u> from Cyprus
- BACKSLASH from Spain
- E-SCHOOL EDUCATIONAL GROUP from Greece
- COMPARATIVE RESEARCH
 NETWORK EV from Germany

The project is funded by Erasmus+, the program of European Commission promoting the development of education in Europe, and is focused on designing training contents and methodologies that promote social media literacy and assist trainers in their teaching of relevant subjects.

HOW ARE WE GOING TO DO IT?

1. A set of **training courses**, which combine youth workers training

sessions and youth learners training sessions. This training courses are divided into two types, the ones addressed to youth workers and the ones addressed to young people. First of all, the youth workers training will be carried on, for later, using this knowledge to be themselves the trainers of the young people trainings.

2. The website, the use of social media (FB) and the creation of a YouTube channel of the ClimateYouths project, which will include the PVs produced by the youth workers and the young learners.

KICKOFF MEETING

The kick-off meeting of the EU funded project "Climate Youths: Youth-Centred Participatory Video Production as a Tool for Empowering Young People to Tackle Climate Change" was implemented on the 20th of January, 2021. The meeting took place online, due to Covid-19 restrictions, with all
