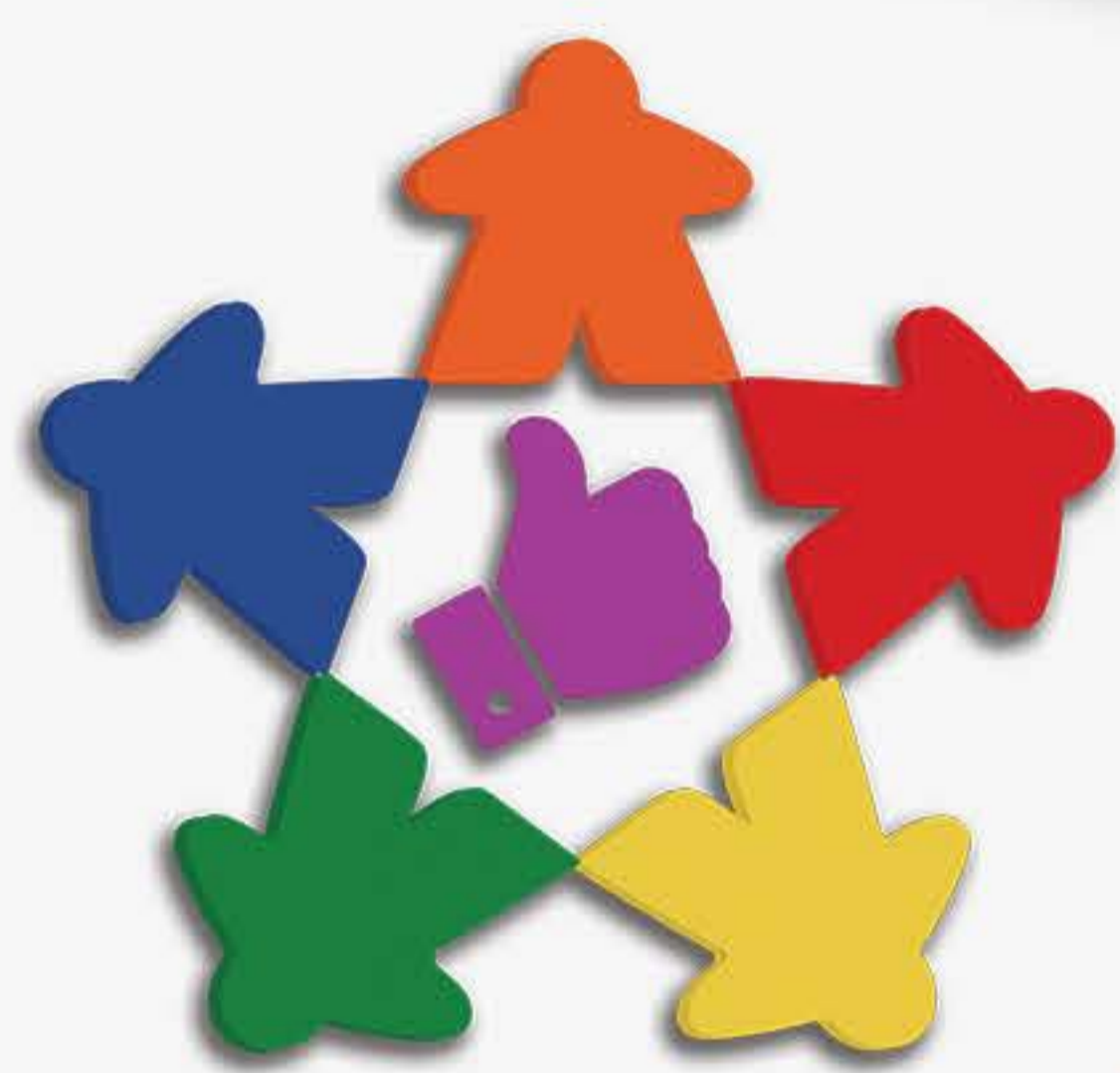
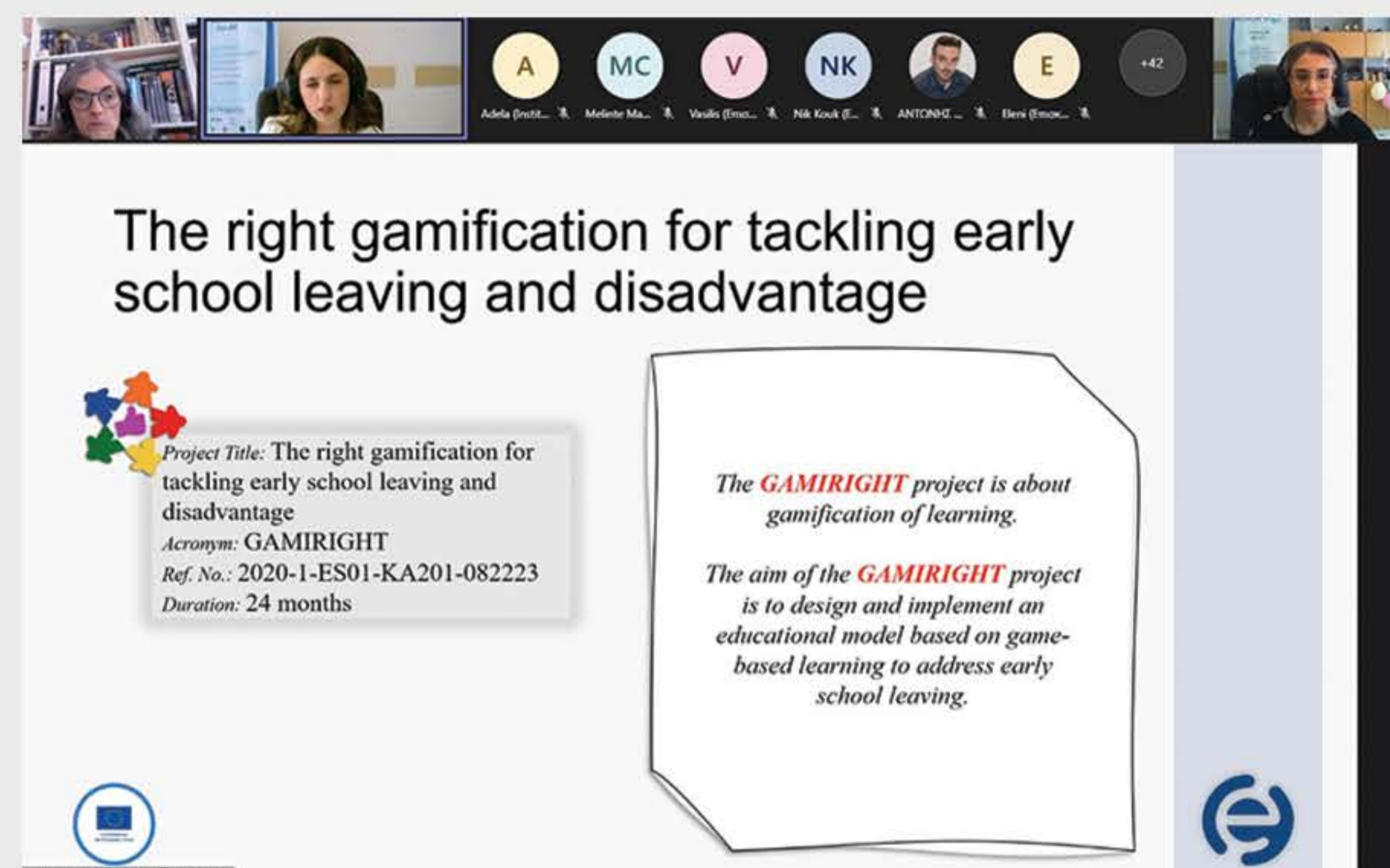
→ The gamification strategy is accompanied by:
