

20 Press Release – AR4EFL project

The second AR4EFL LTTA was held in Chester, UK, from September 26th to September 30th, 2022. Teachers, as representatives of the six organizations involved in this project, had the opportunity to participate in the 5-day activity, review the innovative AR4EFL material, and benefit from it. Participating teachers enjoyed using the Augmented Reality application and lesson plans, and were inspired to incorporate the created content into their own lessons. The LTTA was a great success and fully accomplished its primary objective, which was to instill teachers with confidence regarding the use of new technology in the classroom, as well as how to enhance their professional development and acquire the new skills necessary to teach EFL to the next generation.

The entire week was devoted to the question of how to improve English language learning through Augmented Reality. Participants were shown how, in addition to teaching a foreign language, students can improve their communication, social, and digital skills through student-centered activities. They also investigate ways to guide and assist students in achieving this objective. In addition, teachers presented teaching strategies using the AR app. Thus, they were able to become acquainted with the application's functionality.
