The partners' meeting and training for the project took place from September, 30th to October, 4th 2024 in Tunis, Tunisia! The main activities during this period were the SeHeMe training and the final meeting among the partners. It was an excellent opportunity for our partners to meet, share their knowledge and finalise the outstanding issues of the project before its completion.

During the recent LTTA in Tunis, participants—comprising migrants, international and local students, as well as project partners—engaged in an intensive three-days programme. Five thematic workshops were held: "Journalism for Social Change," "Media Literacy," "Cultural Norms," "Networking" and "Public Speaking." These workshops aimed to empower attendees with skills for active citizenship and effective communication, fostering a collaborative

learning environment.

Following the LTTA, the Final Meeting SeHeMe project took place, where partners reviewed the quality of project discussed the outputs, upcoming SeHeMe events and emphasised for sustainability. strategies discussions included project visibility, with plans for promotional videos and a Community of Practice to maintain long-term engagement. Partners also went through the publicity ensuring all tasks align with the project's goals of supporting newcomers and promoting informed journalism migrant communities.


















## **SEHEME Events**
