## About the competition

OSCAR invites young people aged **15-25** from **Spain, Greece, Malta, Estonia and France** to participate in a creative eco-challenge focused on responsible e-waste management.

The competition aims to motivate youth to:

- understand the environmental & health risks of e-waste
- use their creativity to inspire peers
- become local e-influencers promoting sustainable habits

Submissions must relate to:

- proper disposal / 9Rs / safe handling / reducing toxic exposure / promoting sustainable behaviour / social impact & awareness

Solutions must be simple, replicable, positive, and youth-friendly. The process of creation should not be „scary‘ but inspiring.

## How can I compete?

Participants **choose ONE** of these formats:

### ✓ **Maxium 2 minutes video**

- explain an e-waste problem
- show how to recycle properly
- demonstrate repair or upcycling

### ✓ **1 infographic or poster**

- “Where to recycle in my city?”
- “Top 5 toxic components in your phone”
- “What happens when you throw a charger in the bin?”

### ✓ **1 simple leaflet (1 page)**

- recycling instructions
- the journey of e-waste
- tips for responsible purchasing

### + **A4 Document**

- In addition, participants must also submit a one-page A4 document in English with an explanation on why did they created their digital product and how it will be impactful and motivating for their peers.
